Hill Hill



Hollow plant stems, e.g. reed or bamboo canes



You can collect them yourself or you can buy them from your local DIY store!



Some wire or an empty tin can





**Pruning** shears or a saw

Both are sharp. Be careful with them!

## Instructions:



When using bamboo sections, the closed side with the "knots" should be at the back (for a natural finish).





**Bundle the stems** and tie them together with wire. Alternatively, you can put them in an empty tin can.



**Cut your** materials to a length of between 10 cm and 20 cm.





Find a suitable place to set up your Wild Bee Hotel. Keep it vertical, please!





In the wild, bees seek out upright, solitary plant stems where they can gnaw tunnels.
