"You need..."



1.

Hollow plant stems, e.g. reed or bamboo canes



Advice

You can collect them yourself or you can buy them from your local DIY store!

2.

Pruning shears or a saw



3.

Some wire or an empty tin can



Attention

Both are sharp. Be careful with them!

Instructions:

Advise

When using bamboo sections, the closed side with the "knots" should be at the back (for a natural finish).



Cut your materials to a length of between 10 cm and 20 cm.



2.

Bundle the stems and tie them together with wire. Alternatively, you can put them in an empty tin can.



3.

Find a suitable place to set up your Wild Bee Hotel. Keep it vertical, please!

Because:

In the wild, bees seek out upright, solitary plant stems where they can gnaw tunnels.
